## **PRE-REQUISITES (REQUIRED FOR LOGIN)**

1. Pair your smartwatch with your phone
2. Search for 'MyHyundai with Bluelink' in the 'App Store'
3. Install the app to your phone

## **Steps:**

1. Open the 'Watch' app on your smartphone
2. Scroll to the bottom of the page on the 'Watch' app
3. Tap on the 'INSTALL' button for the 'MyHyundai with Bluelink' app
4. Once the installation is complete, the smartwatch app is ready for use

## Option 1: Play Store on Watch > “Apps on your phone”

### PRE-REQUISITES (REQUIRED FOR LOGIN)

1. Pair your smartwatch with your phone
2. Search for 'MyHyundai with Bluelink' in the 'Play Store'
3. Install the app to your phone

### Steps:

1. Open the 'Play Store' app on your smartwatch
2. Find and tap 'Apps on your phone'
3. Find and tap the 'MyHyundai with Bluelink' app
4. Tap 'Install' to download
5. Once the installation is complete, the smartwatch app is ready for use

## Option 2: Android Debug Method (1/3)

### PRE-REQUISITES:

1. Pair your smartwatch with your phone
2. Connect both your smartwatch and phone to the same Wi-Fi
3. Search for 'MyHyundai with Bluelink' in the 'Play Store'
4. Install the app to your phone

### STEP 1. INSTALL 'WEAR INSTALLER 2'

[Smartphone]

1. Open the 'Play Store' app on your smartphone
2. Search for 'Wear Installer 2' in the 'Play Store' by Malcolm Bryant
3. Signup for early access
4. Install the app

### STEP 2. ENABLE DEVELOPER MODE

[Galaxy Watch]

1. Tap the below menu sequence on your Android device to become a developer:  
Settings > About Watch > Software > Tap seven (7) times on the 'Software version'

[Other WearOs Watches]

2. Tap the below menu sequence on your Android device to become a developer:  
Settings > System > Tap seven (7) times on the 'Build Number'

## Option 2: Android Debug Method (2/3)

### STEP 3. ENABLE DEBUGGING OVER Wi-Fi

[Smartwatch]

1. Open 'Developer options' from the settings on your smartwatch
2. Enable 'ADB debugging'
3. Enable 'Debug over Wi-Fi'

### STEP 4. IDENTIFY THE SMARTWATCH IP ADDRESS

[Watch] IP Address From Developer Options

1. See the IP Address under the 'Debug over WiFi' excluding :5555  
(Example: 192.168.1.1)

[Watch] IP Address From Wi-Fi Settings

1. Open 'Connectivity' from the settings on your watch
2. Open 'WiFi' and tap on the connected network
3. See the IP Address (Example: 192.168.1.1)

### STEP 5. ENTER THE IP ADDRESS

[Smartphone]

1. On your smartphone, enter the IP Address from the previous step into the 'IP Address' textbox in Wear Installer 2 (Do not include the :5555)
2. Tap 'DONE' after the IP Address is entered

## Option 2: Android Debug Method (3/3)

### STEP 6. DEBUG THE APP

[Smartphone]

1. On your smartphone, scroll down the 'Installed apps' and tap the 'Genesis' / 'MyHyundai' app

[Watch]

2. On your watch, select 'OK' or 'Always allow' when prompted with the question "Allow Debugging?"

[Smartphone]

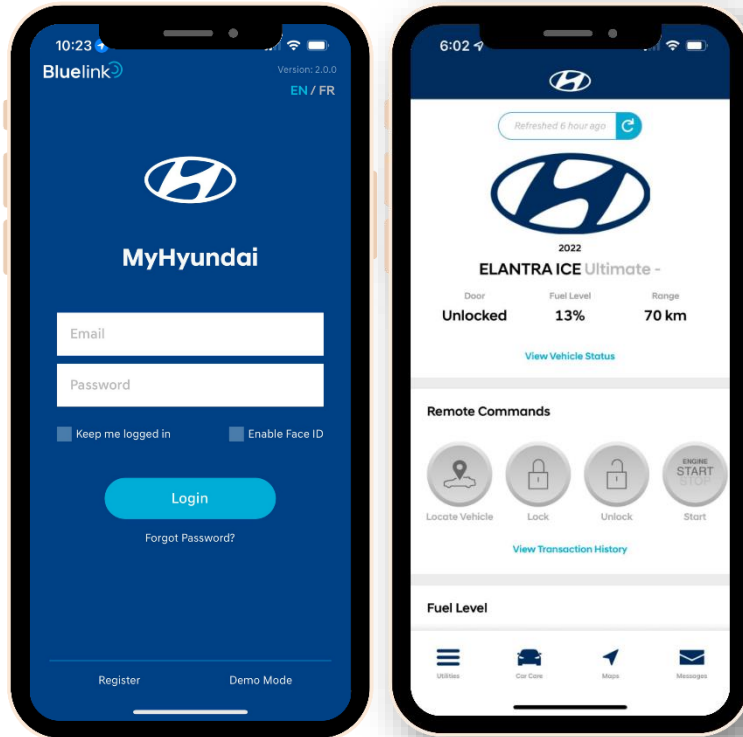
3. Tap 'INSTALL' to install the app on your watch

### TROUBLESHOOTING ISSUES

[Smartphone & Watch]

If you face any issues, restart both your watch and phone then follow the steps above to debug the app
